NAINITAL

JIM CORBETT NATIONAL PARK

Jim Corbett National Park can be befittingly called the paradise of Tigers for the fact that it holds a large population of tigers in its breathtaking landscapes that consists of different varieties of flora and fauna. Named after the legendary tiger hunter turned naturalist Jim Corbett, the proud destination 'Jim Corbett National Park' was the first national park of India, which was established in 1936 in the hill state of Uttarakhand in Northern India. It is one of the most famous wildlife destinations in India, visited by several wildlife enthusiasts who want to catch the glorious sights of the Indian tigers.



PILIBHIT TIGER RESERVE



Pilibhit Tiger Reserve is a major wildlife sanctuary in northern India, established in 2008 and spread across about 727 square kilometers. It is known for its rich biodiversity, natural beauty, and dense forests. The reserve provides habitat to many species of flora and fauna, including several endangered animals. It is especially famous for conserving the majestic Bengal Tiger, India's national animal. The reserve plays an important role in wildlife protection and tiger conservation efforts in India.
